

Safety Instructions

When using electrical units, basic safety precautions should always be followed. Check that the voltage indicated on the rating plate corresponds with that of the

local network before connecting the unit to the mains power supply.

Do not leave the unit unattended whilst connected to another device.

Do not leave the unit unattended whilst connected to the mains power supply. Do not remove the appliance from the mains power supply by pulling the cord; switch it off and remove the plug by hand.

Do not use this unit outdoors.

Do not store the unit in direct sunlight or in high humidity conditions.

Do not move the unit whilst it is in use.

Do not play music at excessive volume levels as damage to hearing and/or the equipment may occur.

It is imperative to unplug the power cord after the unit has been used, before it is cleaned and whilst being repaired.

To prevent possible hearing damage, do not listen at high volume levels for long periods of time.

Battery Safety (Remote Control Only)

Ensure that the battery compartment is secure.

Only a battery of the same or equivalent type as those recommended should be used with this unit.

Only use those batteries recommended.

Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity and should not be exposed to excessive heat sources such as fire and direct sunlight.

Replace a full set of batteries at any one time.

Remove any batteries from the unit when it is not being used for a long period of time to avoid leakage.

Exhausted batteries should be removed from the unit to avoid leakage.

In the event of the battery leaking, do not allow any liquid to come into contact with the skin or eyes. If contact has been made, wash the affected area with copious amounts of water and seek medical advice.

Keep batteries out of reach of children.

Remember to keep button cell batteries away from children at all times as they can easily be swallowed.

Instruction for Use

Using the Bluetooth XL Jukebox

Plug the DC input jack on the power adaptor into the DC input socket on the reverse of the Bluetooth XL Jukebox and then plug the adaptor into the mains power supply. Turn on the Bluetooth XL lukebox by sliding the 'On/Off' switch to 'On'.

Use the 'Source' button on the remote control to change between the Bluetooth, CD and Aux. functions.

Adjust the volume by pressing and holding the 'Skip/Volume +' and 'Skip/Volume -' buttons on the control panel or use the corresponding buttons on the remote control. Instantly cease all sound emitted from the Bluetooth XL Jukebox by pressing the 'Mute' button on the remote control; push it again to resume the sound.

To pause the track, press the 'Play/Pause' button on the control panel or remote control; push it once more to resume playing the track.

Skip tracks by pressing the 'Skip'/Volume +' and 'Skip/Volume -' buttons on the control panel or use the corresponding buttons on the remote control.

To turn the LED lights on and off, use the 'LED On/Off' button on the remote control. Set the Bluetooth XL Jukebox to standby by pressing 'Standby' button on the control panel or remote control.

To turn off the Bluetooth XL Jukebox completely, slide the 'On/Off' switch on the reverse of the unit to 'Off'.

Modes

CD Mode

Inserting a CD

STEP 1: Press the 'Eject' button on the control panel or remote control to open the CD player. STEP 2: Insert the CD to be played with the artwork facing up. Gently press the CD into the disk tray and then close the CD player.

STEP 3: Press the 'Source' button on the remote control until the LED display shows '--'; this will then go on to display the track number, for example '01'. If no CD is inserted, the LED display will show 'no'.

Warning: The CD player utilises a class 1 laser. Always exit CD mode before opening the CD player to remove or change CDs. Never look directly at the laser pickup head.

Listening to a CD

- 1. Pause a track by pressing the 'Play/Pause' button on the control panel or remote control; push it again to resume the track.
- 2. Skip tracks by pressing the 'Skip/Volume +' and 'Skip/Volume -' buttons on the control panel or use the corresponding buttons on the remote control.
- 3. To repeat the current track, press the 'Program/Repeat' button on the control panel or remote control; a red dot will flash to the right of track number shown on the LED display.
- 4. Repeat the entire CD by pressing the 'Program/Repeat' button a second time; the red dot next to the track number will remain solid.
- 5. Cancel the repeat function by pressing the 'Program/Repeat' button once more.
- **6.** To end CD playback, press the 'Stop' button on the control panel or remote control. **Note:** The LED display will show the track number once a CD is playing. When a track is paused, the track number shown on the LED display will flash.

Programming a Playlist

- STEP 1: End CD playback by pressing the 'Stop' button.
- STEP 2: Press and hold the 'Program/Repeat' button on the control panel or remote control; the LED display will flash '01', signalling that a playlist can now be programmed.
- STEP 3: Use the 'Skip/Volume +' and 'Skip/Volume -' buttons on the control panel or the 'Skip +' and 'Skip -' buttons on the remote control to select a track and then press the 'Program/Repeat' button to select it as the first to be played. The LED display will now flash 'O2'.
- STEP 4: Repeat step 3 to set the play order of up to 20 tracks.
- STEP 5: Press the 'Play/Pause' button on the control panel or remote control to begin playback of the new playlist.
- STEP 6: Tracks can be skipped by pressing the 'Skip/Volume +' and 'Skip/Volume -' buttons on the control panel or by using the corresponding buttons on the remote control.
- STEP 7: Cancel programming by pressing the 'Stop' button.
- **Note:** During programming, a red dot will illuminate to the left of the track number show on the LED display.

Bluetooth

- The Bluetooth XL Jukebox will automatically enter the Bluetooth mode when it is turned on and the LED display will flash 'bt'.
- STEP 1: Pair the Bluetooth enabled device with the Bluetooth XL Jukebox by selecting 'EE 1446' from the listed devices. Once a connection has been made, the LED display will show 'bt', to signal that the Bluetooth XL Jukebox is now paired with the Bluetooth compatible device.
- STEP 2: Tracks can be played and skipped using either the Bluetooth enabled device, the control panel on the Bluetooth XL Jukebox or the remote control.
- **STEP 3:** To unpair from the currently connected device, unpair through the device's settings. Alternatively, change modes by pressing the 'Source' button on the control panel or remote control.

Aux. 1

Connect the 3.5 mm cable to the Aux. input jack on the back of the Bluetooth XL Jukebox and the other end to an MP3 player or other compatible audio source. The Bluetooth XL Jukebox will automatically switch to the Aux. mode and the LED display will show 'AU'. Sound can be controlled using the connected device.

Aux. 2

Connect an RCA cable (not included) to the Aux. 2 input jacks on the back of the Bluetooth XL Jukebox and the other end to an audio output device. The Bluetooth XL Jukebox will automatically switch to the Aux. mode and the LED display will show 'A.U'. Sound can be controlled using the connected device.

LED Lights

To turn on and activate the LED lights, press the 'LED On/Off' button on the remote control; press it again to turn off and deactivate the LED lights.

Using the Remote Control

When using the remote control for the first time, remove the clear plastic tab from the rear of the remote control and discard. To open the battery compartment, slide the tab to the right and pull the tray out. Insert or replace the exhausted battery with a CR2025 battery, observing the polarity markings and then close the tray.

Care and Maintenance

Before attempting any cleaning or maintenance, ensure that the Bluetooth XL Jukebox is turned off at the mains power supply and has been unplugged.

Wipe down the Bluetooth XL lukebox with a soft, damp cloth and dry thoroughly.

Do not:

Use abrasive cleaning solvents to clean the Bluetooth XL Jukebox.

Immerse the Bluetooth XL Jukebox in water or any other liquid.

Expose the remote control to extremely high or low temperatures, as this may destroy the battery.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Cause	Solution
No Power	The power adaptor has not been plugged in properly. The Bluetooth XL Jukebox has not been switched on at the mains power supply. The Bluetooth XL Jukebox is in standby mode.	Ensure that the power adaptor has been properly connected. Switch on the Bluetooth XL Jukebox at the mains power supply. Press the 'Standby' button on the remote control.
No Sound	The volume level is set too low.	Check that the volume level is set at an audible level and adjust accordingly with the remote control, control panel or paired Bluetooth device.
Unable to pair a device with the Bluetooth XL Jukebox.	The Bluetooth device is not compatible with the Bluetooth XL Jukebox.	Ensure that the Bluetooth device is compatible with the Bluetooth XL Jukebox and that the Bluetooth function on the device is switched on.
	The Bluetooth XL Jukebox has not been set to the correct source mode.	Press the 'Source' button on the remote control until the LED display flashes 'bt', then search for 'EE1446' and select to pair.
The CD is skipping/ will not play.	The CD is dirty/scratched.	Gently clean the CD in small, circular motions with a non-static cloth, working from the inside out.
The remote control is not working.	The batteries are exhausted.	Replace the battery with a 3 V CR2025.


